Tuition Costs

- Tuition costs are calculated by the total number of units you are taking. Undergraduate students taking courses for credit are charged **\$55 per unit/credit**. The tuition cost is **\$35 per unit** if you are not taking a course for credit (as an “Audit” student). For example: A three-unit course would either cost \$165 (for credit) or \$105 (for audit). **Please use the space below to calculate your total costs.**
- Online courses are the only exception—they will be \$200 per course (includes books) - whether you take them for credit or audit.**
- Masters Students pay \$250 per course (books are included except for supplemental textbooks.)**
